## PRIMARY SCHOOL BOOKLISTS & CLASS REQUIREMENTS

*You have the option of supplying the required items on the booklist or paying the levy for the year.*

*All students are expected to have the correct equipment for learning by the end of the second week of school. Please note, if you have not bought the required items, an invoice will be sent home to pay the book levy.*

*Students who are not prepared with the correct equipment, will find it difficult to begin their studies properly.*

### **Student School Bag:**

It is important that every student has their own school bag to store all their belongings. Each student should have in their school bag:

- 1 x Large Pencil case
- 8 x HB Pencils
- 1 x 30cm Ruler
- 2 x pack of Glue Sticks
- 2 x Coloured Pencils
- 4 x pack of Rubbers
- 4 x Pencil Sharpeners
- 1 x Highlighter Pack

### **Grades 1 to 3 classroom requirements:**

- 6 x Exercise Books (blue & red lined)
- 6 x Grid Books (10mm)
- 6 x scrapbooks
- 2 x Reams of A4 paper
- 6 x A4 64 page Exercise Books (grade 3 only)

### **Grade 4 to 6 classroom requirements**

- 3 x Reams of A4 paper
- 6 x Exercise Books
- 6 x Grid Books (7mm)
- 4 x Scrapbooks
- 4 x A4 Exercise Books (96 page)

# CENTREPAY

*Centrepay – the easy way to pay your bills and expenses. Centrepay is a voluntary bill-paying service that is free for Centrelink customers. Use Centrepay to arrange regular Deductions from your Centrelink payment. You can start or change a Deduction at any time the quickest way to do it is through your Centrelink account online.*

Families can make a contribution to the costs of what is supplied to your child. These include:

- Education Fees: Book Levy/ Art Levy/ Text Book Hire/ Paper Levy
- Nutrition Fees: Breakfasts and Lunches (from \$20 per week)
- Travel Fees: School Bus Fees (from \$5 per week)

Unfortunately, we cannot include uniform, excursion or camp expenses to the Centrepay Deductions - these will need to be paid upfront. Lunch will not be provided until the deduction begins (the tuck-shop will be notified when it starts).

If you are interested in using Centrepay, please **contact the school office** and we can help you get started. However, you will need to arrange the deduction with Centrelink directly by using our service provider CRN below:

## **\$1.00 PER DAY / PER CHILD**

Our school buses are ageing and we need your help to maintain a valuable service provided to your children.

In 2008, we implemented a bus levy to help us with the rising costs of:

- Fuel
- Tolls
- Vehicle Maintenance

The school bus only costs \$1.00 per day/per child. We have kept these costs at a minimum price. Regular payments can be made to the bus driver.
